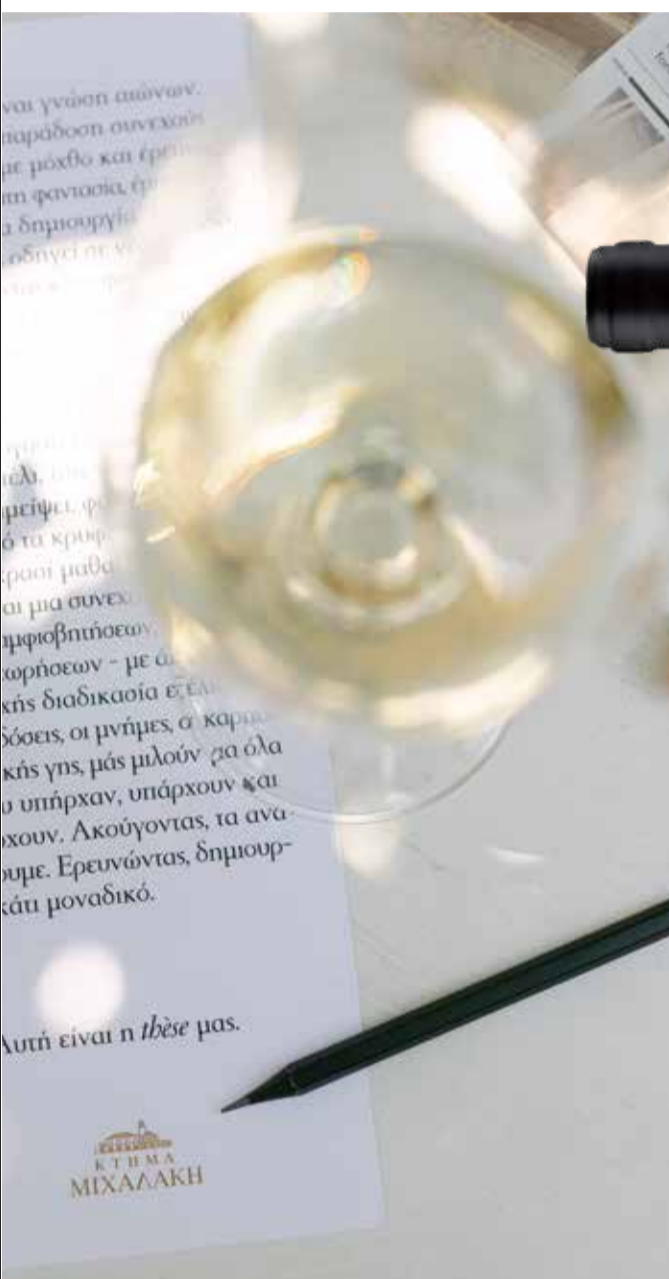

The Cretan Vidiano and Moschato Spinas varieties are grown in a vineyard surrounding Vathypetro, the world's oldest known wine press used by the ancient Minoans to foot-crush grapes to make their famous vintages. Today, having a deep-rooted connection to this historic land, we combine tradition with the latest advances in viticulture and winemaking to create an aromatic white that stands out for its elegance and finesse.

Assyrtiko · Vidiano · Sauvignon Blanc

From select vineyards surrounding the Monastery of St. George Epanosiphis at an altitude of 600m, an exciting blend of Assyrtiko, Greece's celebrated white cultivar, Vidiano, Crete's robust grape variety, and locally grown Sauvignon Blanc. The vineyards are perched on limestone hillslopes with an inclination of up to 12%, while much attention has been paid to establishing a leaf wall to guard against the hot Cretan summer.

Cretan Kotsifali, popular Syrah, and versatile Grenache have long been cultivated in the wine region surrounding the Monastery of St. George Epanosiphis, on impoverished limestone soils at an altitude of 600m. An early harvest rosé produced using a rigorous winemaking methodology.
