Vinification: Careful selection of the grapes and pressing in modern pneumatic presses, skin contact for 1-2 hours at 8°C and collection of free run must. Static clarification and alcoholic fermentation at low

tem-peratures. The wine matures in its fine lees for 2 months.

Sensory Characteristics: Pale lemon.

Rich metal character, pear, apple and white peach aromas.

Distinctive persistent acidity with great minerality and flavors of grapefruit, ginger and mint. Harmony of flavors: Fried seafood, oily fish, shellfish, white meats freckles and ripe cheeses.
